Admission

Students are admitted to our High School after a successful interview to determine the child's ability for proper placement.

For registration the following are required:

1. All students registering for forms 1 - 5 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
2. Previous school reports/certificates etc.
3. Two passport size photographs.
4. Students registering for the first time must pay a registration fee of \$ 1,000.
5. Students must register for a term. However, fees can be paid on a monthly basis for some programmes.
6. Parent/guardian, student and principal must affix their signatures to our 'Parent as Partners Agreement.'
7. Upon completion of registration, students must ensure that they collect:
